### Sociology

The Sociology Department supports the principles and guidelines contained within the Tring School Home Learning Policy.

At KS5 students can expect to receive at least one examination question and/or past examination paper every four weeks. Students are always given guidance in class on how to approach an assessment and this is often accompanied by checklists and grade booster comments. Should students fail to meet their target grade, they may be asked to re-do part or all of the question.

In addition to the above students are also required to do the necessary reading for the lessons which may involve note taking and research. Maintaining awareness of current sociological issues is vital and students are expected to keep abreast of topical issues. This can be achieved by reading a quality newspaper, viewing appropriate TV material such as Panorama and making full use of the Sociology Review magazine located in the School's Learning Centre. It is advisable that students subscribe to this magazine, which aims to enhance subject knowledge by providing guidance from senior examiners.
